Restoration News

The City of Llano hired the Pat Sparks Engineering Group again (they produced our initial engineering assessment) to help us with the next phase of restoration – bracing of the front and back gables and shoring up the roof.

Restoration News, Cont.

As you know, local contractor Dennis Masterson was hired by the City of Llano to do some immediate repair work to the roof to prevent further leakage. Mr. Masterson was there to walk through the attic with Rick Miles of the Sparks Group and they discussed the roof restoration project. Masterson had questions that Rick Miles could answer directly. He is starting work on the roof as we send this newsletter.

What's Next?

RESTORATION: The window in the southwest corner of the gallows has fallen apart. The bricks below it have given out and the window has been replaced with a board. This window is a main source of leakage into the gallows and needs restoration. If any of you know someone who can restore the masonry, wood, glass or other parts of the jail to its original glory, please call Randy Farnsworth at the City of Llano. He is compiling a list of potential contractors who are willing to bid on future projects for the Red Top Jail and other City of Llano projects. The City of Llano will proceed with a standardized bidding process for all Red Top Jail restoration projects in the future. If you are interested, call Randy Farnsworth and get on the list!

Sheri Zoch contacted the Source Group in Galveston that specializes in determining accurate color matching of historical buildings. The Komatsu group suggested that they analyze the red pigment on the roof to determine the most accurate color match by Sherwin Williams or other modern day paint manufacturers. Since we have samples of the roof from the last time the LCRA bucket truck came into town, the Source Gp. thinks that they can do this for around \$550. By the way, the day-glow orange found underneath some of the steel roof could have been a primer that was often used in those early days.

If anyone you know has any photos, either black and white or color, with the Red Top roof in the background, please let us know. This will be VITAL for an accurate color match of the roof. Check your archives! NEXT GENERAL MEETING. I know, can you believe it? The next general meeting of our group is on my birthday, July 18! We will reassess our goals, vote on new board members and decide on a mission statement for our group. This will be your chance to relax, have some good food, drink and be merry with new and old friends. We will have music, BarBQ, and libations. Please come and bring your checkbook!
